

BACKPAGE COMPENSATION PROGRAM



The U.S. Department of Justice announced the process for compensating individuals who were sex trafficked through advertisements hosted on Backpage.com and/or CityXGuide.com.

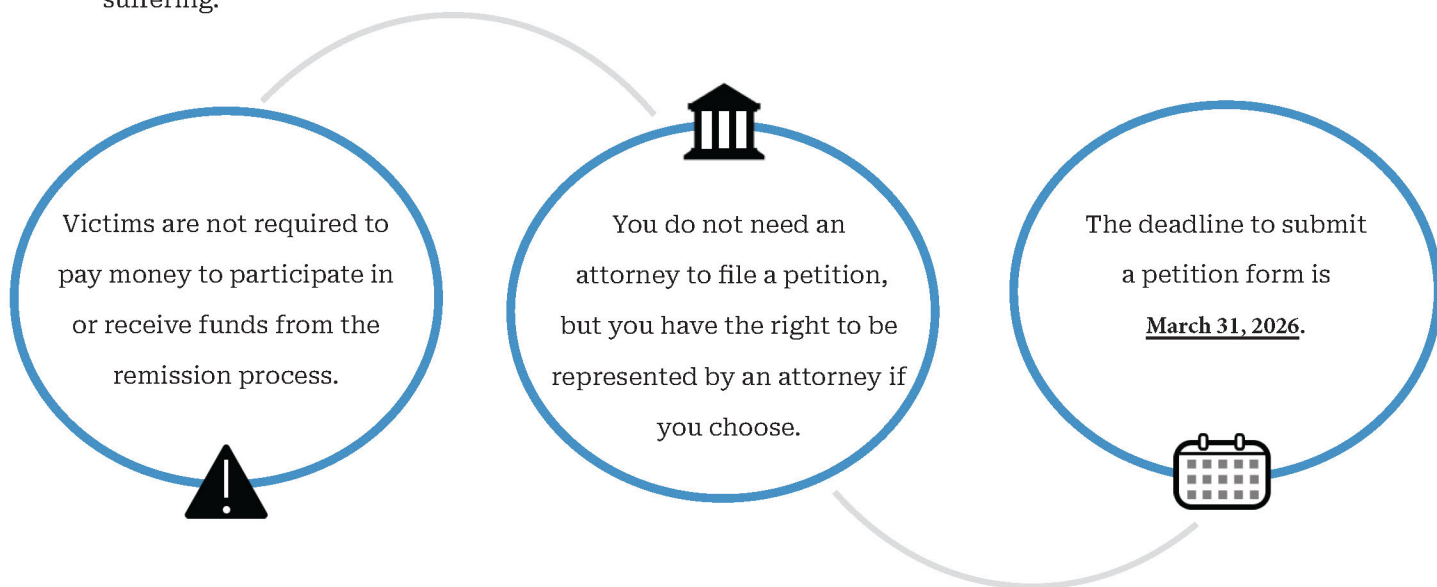
ELIGIBILITY FOR COMPENSATION

Petitioners must establish

- ✓ They were sex trafficking victims advertised on **Backpage** at any time during January 1, 2004, to April 6, 2018, and/or CityXGuide at any time during April 8, 2018, to June 19, 2020.
- ✓ Incurred monetary losses caused by the sex trafficking, which are supported by documentation. Losses that are not monetary in nature, are unrelated to the trafficking crimes, or are not supported by documentation, are not eligible for compensation. Examples of non-compensable losses include future economic losses and pain and suffering.
